ORDER

As per the G.O. read as 1st paper above, a Project Management unit (PMU) was constituted for the effective management of the projects assigned to LSGD, as part of Rebuild Kerala initiative, with the aid of World Bank, with one Executive Engineer (Project Director), three Assistant Executive Engineers and four Assistant Engineers.

The Chief Engineer, LSGD, as per the letters read as 2nd and 3rd papers above, has informed that it is difficult to function the PMU with the above staff pattern and submitted a proposal for creation of new posts for Rebuild Kerala for the effective functioning of the Project Management Unit. It is further requested that Project Implementation Units shall also be created for district wise execution of projects for the eight flood affected districts . It is also informed by the Chief Engineer, LSGD, that the World Bank will allow 3 Million Dollars as Administration charges in the first stage and will allow more as new projects for additional road works will be initiated in the second stage.

Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to create the following posts for the next five years for the functioning of Project Management Unit and Project Implementation Unit proposed to be created for Rebuild Kerala Initiative in order to carry out the projects assigned to Local Self Government Department, in addition to the team of 1 Executive Engineer, 3 Assistant Executive Engineers and 4 Assistant Engineers already created as per the G.O. read as 1st paper above.
