ORDER

In the aftermath of the flood of 2018, RKI has been entrusted with the task of planning and implementing a rebuilding strategy for the state as per the G.O. read as 1st paper above. High quality and durable road infrastructure are pre-requisite for social, economic and industrial development of any state. The Local Self Government Department submitted project proposals for rebuilding roads at a total length of 614.6 km under Phase-1, with an estimated requirement of funds to the tune of ₹488 crore from the RKI. The High-Level Empowered Committee (HLEC) of RKI, in its meeting held on 06/07/2019, approved the proposal, and consequently, in-principle sanction was accorded for taking up of the project under RKI as per the G.O. read as 4th paper above. Consequently, the Local Self Government Department submitted the Detailed Project Report with respect to 3 districts viz. Pathanamthitta, Idukki and Wayanad with an estimated requirement of ₹266.30 crore, and Administrative Sanction was accorded to the projects as per G.O. read 5th above, with the Project

Management Unit (PMU)-LSGD as the implementing agency. Later, the PMU-LSGD submitted the DPRs of 25 roads from this list in Alappuzha, Kottayam, Ernakulam and Thrissur districts for a total length of 39.89 km at an estimated cost of Rs. 53.14 crore, and Administrative Sanction was accorded to the projects as per G.O. read 6th above.

2. Now, the PMU-LSGD submitted the DPRs of 21 roads from the approved list in Alappuzha, Kottayam, Ernakulam, Thrissur and Wayanad districts for a total length of 26.85 km at an estimated cost of Rs.40 crore. The district-wise details of roads are consolidated below.

3. The proposal was placed before the HLEC in its meeting held on 13/10/2020. The HLEC, as per the minutes read as 7th paper above, approved the Detailed Project Report for the roads in the 5 districts, and directed to issue Administrative Sanction for the same.

4. In these circumstances, the Government are pleased to accord Administrative Sanction for the implementation of the project of reconstruction of LSGD roads in the 5 districts (*list of roads attached at **Annexure** to this G.O.*), under the Rebuild Kerala Initiative at an estimated cost of **Rs.40 crore (Rupees Forty crore only)**. The expenditure in this regard will be debited to the budget provision under H/A 5475-00-115-94-Post flood Projects under Rebuild Kerala Initiative (P).

5. The Local Self Government Department shall implement the projects through the Project Management Unit created in the Department for undertaking works connected with Rebuild Kerala Initiative.

6. The Departmental Committee constituted under the Local Self Government Department, as mandated in para 76 of the G.O. read as 1st paper above, shall work with the RKI-IC to coordinate, monitor and implement the approved projects.


