ORDER

In the aftermath of the flood of 2018, RKI has been entrusted with the task of planning and implementing a rebuilding strategy for the state as per the G.O. read as 1st paper above. As per the G.O. read as 3rd paper above, Government had approved the Rebuild Kerala Development Programme (RKDP) which constitutes the State's strategic road map for a Green and Resilient Kerala. It encompasses cross cutting and sector based recommendations on policy, regulatory and institutional actions as well as priority investment programmes that are critical for resilient and sustainable recovery and rebuilding of the state. The G.O., read as 1st paper above, also details the operational strategy and

institutional framework which deals with deployment and utilization of funds for speedy execution of projects under RKI.

2. The Local Self Government Department submitted project proposals for rebuilding roads with an estimated requirement of funds to the tune of ₹488 crore from the RKI. The proposal was placed before the HLEC in its meeting held on 06/07/2019. The HLEC, as per the minutes read as 4th paper above, approved the proposal and the same was placed before the Council of Ministers for consideration. As approved by the Council of Ministers, in-principle sanction was accorded for taking up of the project under RKI as per the G.O. read as 5th paper above. Consequently, the Local Self Government Department submitted the Detailed Project Report with respect to 3 districts viz. Pathanamthitta, Idukki and Wayanad with an estimated requirement of ₹266.30 crore, for which Government accorded Administrative Sanction as per G.O. read as 6th paper above.

3. In the meeting convened by Minister, LSGD on 11/12/2019, the minutes of which is read as paper 7 above, the PMU was directed to take urgent steps to outsource the survey related activities for the remaining roads in all districts, especially like in Wayanad district. Further, in the meeting held with ACS, LSGD in the chamber of CEO, RKI on 11/02/2020, the minutes of which is read as paper 8 above, it was decided that surveying of the remaining roads in various districts shall be completed urgently, for which the Project Director shall issue open tender and/or if necessary, shall approach select colleges, to undertake the surveying, within one week thence.

4. Now, the Project Director, PMU-LSGD, as per letter read 9th above, has submitted proposal for investigation/ data collection of remaining roads identified in 7 districts viz. Pathanamthitta, Alappuzha, Kottayam, Idukki, Ernakulam, Thrissur and Wayanad, and has requested to issue Administrative Sanction for conducting field studies by outsourcing the work through open tender. The cost estimate for the task is Rs.4,75,00,000/- (Rupees Four crore and Seventy-Five lakh only). The district-wise break up of the amount is as follows.

Expenditure in this regard will be debited to the budget provision under H/A 5475-00-115-94-Post flood Projects under Rebuild Kerala Initiative (P).

6. The work shall be awarded to a competent agency through a fair and transparent selection procedure.


