ORDER

As per G.O read paper 1st above, in principle sanction was accorded for the reconstruction of 41st mile Varayal bridge in Thanival GP in Wayanad District, which was washed away in the flood in 2018. Further, as per G.O. read paper 2nd above, 42 LSGD bridges/culverts were decided to be reconstructed under RKI through PMU-RKI-LSGD, which included the said bridge, and later, as per G.O read 3rd above, sanction was accorded for the soil investigation of 46 bridges including the said bridge.

2. The Project Director, PMU-RKI-LSGD submitted the DPR/estimate for the reconstruction of the 41st mile Varayal bridge at an estimated cost of ₹ 2 crore, and requested to issue Administrative Sanction for the same.

3. The High Level Empowered Committee (HLEC) in its 21st meeting held on 17-08-2023, the minutes of which may be read as paper 4th above, approved the DPR/estimate, and authorized the RKI to issue administrative sanction for the project, at an estimated cost of ₹ 2 crore. The financial requirements of the project is as follows;
