ORDER

As per references cited as 2nd above, in-principle approval was accorded for the reconstruction of 614.6 Km of flood damaged LSGD roads with an estimated requirement of funds to the tune of ₹488 crore from the RKI, which included Moorthitta Mukkatheri Valayil Chakkittapalam Valakali road in Alappuzha District.

2. The Project Director, PMU submitted the DPR for reconstruction of the road for a stretch of 4.2 km which starts at Moorthitta junction and ends at Vallakali, with a cost estimate of ₹15.20 crore. A rigid pavement with minimum envisaged carriageway of 3.75 m is proposed for the road, and the work also includes construction/reconstruction of culverts and one minor bridge as well. The estimate of the work is summarised as follows;

The RKI-Implementation Committee (RKI-IC) meeting held on 31-07-2023, the minutes of which may be read as paper 3rd above, considered the proposal and recommended the same, subject to the condition that the Panchayath should make available sufficient land to ensure the minimum carriageway proposed throughout the entire length of the road, before tendering the work.

4. Subsequently, the 21st High Level Empowered Committee (HLEC) of RKI, the minutes of which may be read as paper 4th above, considered the proposal, and authorized the RKI to issue administrative sanction for the work, at an estimated cost ₹15.20 crore. The Government, after having considered the matter in detail, are pleased to issue Administrative Sanction for the **Reconstruction of Moorthitta Mukkatheri Valayil Chakkittapalam Valakali road (with a length of 4.2 km) in Alappuzha District**, at an estimated cost of **₹15,20,000,00/- (Fifteen crore and Twenty lakh Rupees Only)**, subject to the condition laid out by the RKI-IC as noted in **para 3** above. The expenditure in this regard shall be debited to the budget provision under H/A 5475-00- 115-94 Post flood Projects under Rebuild Kerala Initiative (P).

5. The Local Self Government Department shall implement the project through the Project Management Unit created in the Department for undertaking works connected with Rebuild Kerala Initiative. The Department shall ensure timely completion of the project. All mandatory clearances from relevant departments shall be obtained wherever applicable. All procurement as part of implementation of the work shall be done in a fair and transparent manner in accordance with the extant rules.
